Dear Mr. Rosenblatt:

I am in receipt of your Motion to Disqualify Councilman Shawn Wooden From Taking Part In The Removal Hearings related to your client, Olga Vazquez. Your motion is based on the entirely false assertion that a law partner of City Council President Wooden at the firm of Day Pitney has been engaged by the Council to serve as a prosecutor in this case. That assertion is incorrect. The Court of Common Council engaged me and my firm, Shipman & Goodwin, to prosecute the charges against your client. Day Pitney and Mr. Rotondo will have no role in the prosecution. These facts are evident from the face of the Resolution appointing me and my firm, as well as from all of the press coverage of this case.

In light of the above, I assume you will withdraw your motion. In addition, going forward I ask that we work cooperatively to avoid unnecessary litigation. The citizens of Hartford should not be burdened by undue expense or disruption.
