WPM's [Caroline Ballard](#) was chosen to participate in NPR's [Audio Storytelling Workshop](#), where public media creators will bring their ideas to D.C. for three days of planning, training, and collaborating. NPR received more than 100 applications. Caroline submitted "Gender Parity Problem in State Legislatures" as her topic, which builds on WPM's recent forum with Leap Into Leadership and Leadership Wyoming Class of 2016. Caroline will work with Utah Public Radio on a radio series that addresses this issue in states with low female

legislative representation. Caroline was also recognized by [WNYC](#) in their [A Magnificent List of 111 Female Hosted Podcasts \(And Counting\)](#) for her work with [HumaNature](#).
