Re: Conduct Review for Admission

Dear Clay:

Your application to the University of South Florida has been referred to our office for review. We took your application to the Admissions Prior Conduct Review Team (APCRT) for consideration. The APCRT has completed its review of your prior conduct and made the determination that your application cannot be recommended to move forward in the admission process. The APCRT's rationale is below.

Clay, you having been previously expelled from the USF system through the disciplinary process. Once a student is expelled, they cannot be considered for re-admission to the USF System and therefore, your application could not be recommended to the Office of Admissions. The sanction of expulsion results in a permanent termination of an individual's privilege to attend the USF system. Furthermore, the Review Team also recognizes that you are currently on felony probation stemming from the legal charges you incurred. The combination of the severity of the incident and the current felony probation would also result in the Review Team not recommending the application to move forward in the admission process.
