WUWM MILWAUKEE PUBLIC RADIO is a public media service of the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee. All content created by WUWM staff is protected by copyright held by the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System. We are flattered, however, when we are asked by listeners to use or share our materials. These guidelines outline when explicit permission is necessary to use WUWM's content and when WUWM's content may not be republished.

FREE USE (No Permission Required)

Personal Use

You may make use of WUWM's content for your own personal, non-commercial use. But we do not allow individuals to redistribute or modify our work in whole or in part.

Linking To Our Site

You may link to content on WUWM's website, but please be careful that you do not make it appear that WUWM is endorsing or promoting any product, service, idea or website. We take our mission as a public service very seriously, and we ask that you do not put us in a position where someone would question our neutrality. We reserve the right to withdraw permission for any link.

Academic Use

WUWM's mission is to inform and educate. Teachers may make up to 30 copies of our stories for classroom use. Please make sure that each copy recognizes that the work originated from WUWM Milwaukee Public Radio and that the work is copyrighted by the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System. Educators may use audio from WUWM's website in the classroom. Permission to distribute more than 30 copies must be approved in writing from the Director/General Manager of WUWM Radio.

Unless your contemplated use falls under Fair Use Laws (http://copyright.gov/fair-use/more-info.html), any other use must be approved in writing from the Director/General Manager of WUWM Radio.

LICENSE REQUIRED (Explicit Permission Required)

Formal permission for the use of WUWM material is required for other uses. This includes, but is not limited to, movies, television, presentations, newspapers, books or performances. Licensing fees are determined on a case-by-case basis.

PROHIBITED USE

WUWM typically does not grant permission to use station materials in advertising, fundraising, marketing and promotional activities. The station will not grant permission for the use of its content for any political activity by candidates, parties, PACs or any similar organization. WUWM logos and registered trademarks may not be used, except by authorized partners. WUWM is also not able to grant permission to use material which the station acquires by license from another source (i.e., NPR, BBC, Associated Press, Getty Images, etc.).
