WHEREAS, the City of Rhinelander terminated the employment of Kristina Aschenbrenner as City Administrator on August 29, 2016; and

WHEREAS, according to media reports interviewing the former City Administrator regarding the termination, a lawsuit regarding the employment of the former City Administrator may be likely; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Rhinelander to cease further communication between any elected official of the City of Rhinelander, employee of the City, vendor and/or independent contractor regarding the past employment or future potential litigation with the former City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, all information regarding the former City Administrator's employment shall be maintained in strict confidence by all elected officials, except as hereinafter provided, and shall not be disclosed for any reason to any other person without the City Council's prior consent, except as otherwise required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Rhinelander hereby imposes a confidentiality directive and mandate over all elected officials, employees of the City of Rhinelander, vendors and/or independent contractors regarding the employment and possible litigation of the former City Administrator and to cease any communication with the former City Administrator in regards to such.
