

Florida Covering Kids & Families

The geographic scope for this service is statewide focusing on 10 regions, which are outlined below. The project will have 2.5 mobile navigators to travel statewide.

Families Count

The geographic scope for this service is the ten (10) westernmost counties of Northwest Florida included in Congressional Districts 1 and 2: Escambia, Santa Rosa, Okaloosa, Walton, Holmes, Jackson, Washington, Calhoun, Gulf, and Bay.

3 mobile navigators to provide advocacy, enrollment and follow-up for insurance assistance for the program in a 10 county area.

Florida CHAIN

Nine navigators to enroll individuals at enrollment fairs.

Statewide populations between 100 and 400 of the federal poverty level in the 10 regions targeted (63 of the 67 counties in Florida excluding Monroe, Miami-Dade and Broward Counties). These include rural and urban areas, with large concentrations of the uninsured in the cities of Tampa, St. Petersburg, Jacksonville, West Palm Beach, and Orlando.
