






On 05/20/2017 at approximately 1345 hours, at the Wal-Mart Supercenter located in Commerce, Hunt County, Texas, Chief Kerry Crews identified himself as a Police Officer to (Ponder, Carmen b/f/08311993) by displaying his government issued police identification card. Chief Crews then informed Ponder that she was being detained pending an investigation of an official complaint made to the Commerce Police Department and told her not to leave. Ponder evaded detention by walking away from Chief Crews and reentered Wal-Mart. Ponder stated to Chief Crews as she was walking away, "Wait while I find my witness."

**Details:**

On 05/20/2017 at 1336 hours, I, Sgt. Beelitz, was dispatched to the Wal-Mart Supercenter to meet with (Beane, Wanda w/f/ in reference to a reckless driver. I was informed by dispatch that Beane's daughter was learning how to drive and was run off the roadway. Dispatch further informed me the suspect vehicle is currently at Wal-Mart. While in route, dispatch advises me to step it up per Chief Crews. I arrived on scene and met with Chief Crews who immediately instructed me to handcuff (Ponder, Carmen b/f/08311993) approximately three times and stated that she needs to go to jail. I proceeded to apply my hand restraints on Ponder and she stated, "Do not tell him to handcuff me," referring to Chief Crew's directive. Chief Crews stated to Ponder, "I'm his boss. I'm telling him what to do." After handcuffing Ponder I attempted to escort her to my patrol vehicle.

Ponder tried to prevent the escort by stopping and refusing to walk. I instructed Ponder to walk but she continued



to stop and turn around in attempt to talk with somebody that was located in the area of the Wal-Mart entrance. While standing at my patrol unit, Chief Crews informed Ponder that she was detained. Ponder stated that she did nothing wrong and chose not to speak with me or Chief Crews. Ponder then entered my patrol unit as instructed and I stepped away and spoke with Chief Crews.

Chief Crews stated to me that he was approached by (Beane, Michael w/m \_\_\_\_\_, regarding a reckless driver. Chief Crews stated M. Beane identified Ponder exiting Wal-Mart as the driver of the vehicle who ran his daughter off the road. Chief Crews stated he approached Ponder and identified himself as a Police Officer by displaying his government issued police identification card. Chief Crews stated he told Ponder that she was being detained and told her not to leave. Chief Crews stated Ponder turned away from him and began walking back in the store. Chief Crews stated as Ponder was walking away she stated, "Wait while I find my witness." Chief Crews stated he went towards Ponder and stopped her inside the entrance doors of Wal-Mart just before I arrived on scene.

(Hill, Richard w/m/ \_\_\_\_\_ was at Wal-Mart during this time and stated to me that he recorded the interaction between Chief Crews and Ponder on his cell phone. I spoke with M. Beane and W. Beane. W. Beane stated her 15 year old daughter, a newly permitted driver, was driving and entered the turning lane on Loop 178. W. Beane stated her daughter proceeded to turn into the Wal-Mart parking lot. W. Beane stated a silver Honda Civic bearing Texas LP: \_\_\_\_\_ came from behind them on the left hand side and ran them off the road near the grass by the Magnuson Hotel. W. Beane stated her daughter got upset and M. Beane took over and drove them into the Wal-Mart parking lot. W. Beane stated M. Beane stopped beside Ponder's vehicle and stated to Ponder, "You just ran my daughter off the road! What are you doing?" W. Beane stated the driver smiled, pointed at her phone and continued her conversation. W. Beane stated when Ponder got out of her vehicle, M. Beane repeated himself to Ponder. W. Beane stated Ponder laughed and said, "She doesn't need to be driving" and then walked into Wal-Mart. W. Beane stated M. Beane called her a "Bitch" and then parked his vehicle.

I provided M. Beane and W. Beane with affidavits and remained on scene while they completed those affidavits. During this time I could hear Ponder talking loudly and kicking the door while in the back of my patrol unit. Officer Sonntag arrived on scene to collect affidavits from W. Beane and M. Beane allowing me to transport Ponder to the Commerce City Jail. As I was leaving Wal-Mart Ponder began chanting repeatedly, "Black Lives Matter!" Ponder stated to me, "You just don't know who I know." Ponder told me a name and asked if I knew that person and I told her I did not. Ponder stated, "That's a shame, you should keep up with the media. That's ok, you'll know who that is when I'm done with you." While in book in I informed Ponder of her charge and began the book in process. Ponder stated to me, "What kind of woman marries you? What was she thinking?" I ignored Ponder's comments and continued with the book in process.

According to M. Beane's affidavit, he states his 15 year old daughter was driving south on the West Service Road in front of the Children's Museum. M. Beane stated his daughter made turned right onto Culver Street and proceeded to enter the left turn lane. M. Beane stated once she entered the turn lane, a Silver Honda came up behind her at a high rate of speed. M. Beane stated he checked the right mirror to make sure there was enough room to make a turn. M. Beane stated his daughter went to make a left turn into Wal-Mart. M. Beane stated as she was half way through her turn, the silver car shot past them on the left. M. beane stated his daughter made the turn but had to avoid hitting the car by going into the hotel parking lot. M. Beane stated the silver car proceeded through the parking lot at a high rate of speed. M. Beane stated he then took over for his daughter. M. Beane stated he pulled up next to the silver car and told Ponder that she ran his daughter off the road. M. Beane stated Ponder proceeded to laugh and point at her phone. M. Beane stated he repeated himself to Ponder and that Ponder reached under her seat. M. Beane stated he backed away and got back in his vehicle. M. Beane stated at this time, Ponder got out of her vehicle. M. Beane stated he told Ponder that she ran his daughter off the road. M. Beane states Ponder stated to him, "Well, she shouldn't be driving." M. Beane stated to Ponder, "Fuck you" and pulled into a parking spot. M. Beane stated he saw Chief Crews leaving Wal-Mart and made contact with him. M. Beane stated he explained the reckless driving situation to Chief Crews and then saw Ponder exiting Wal-Mart. M. Beane stated that Chief Crews identified himself to Ponder as a Police Officer and showed her his I.D.

M. Beane stated Ponder kept walking and ignored the Officer's orders. M. Beane stated at this time an off duty Officer, identified as Hill, Richard, assisted Chief Crews. M. Beane stated Ponder refused to follow orders and tried to leave.
