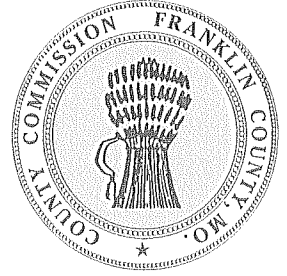

Comments	Due to the technical nature of the proposed use, the Zoning Administrator has relied upon the expert opinions of the Independent Registered Professional Engineer retained by Franklin County pursuant to Section 238 of the Franklin County Unified Land Use Regulations. The Independent Registered Professional Engineer (Andrews Engineering) has determined that the proposed development, if built as designed, would meet all requirements of the Franklin County Unified Land Use Regulations. Furthermore, construction of the development must be monitored by the Independent Registered Professional Engineer (Cochran Engineering) retained by Franklin County for such purpose. Cochran Engineering's task will be to ensure that construction complies with the plans, as well as, all County Regulations. With respect to the application at hand, a zoning permit is required because the project will involve substantial clearing, grading and excavating and will also involve the construction of substantial structures in the form of concrete "cells."
